My team and I are excited about the prospect of your child attending this year's weeklong Summer Camp. Their facility will accommodate 300 campers in air-conditioned cabins that each have private showers and bathroom facilities. There is also a rock water slide, a zip line, sports fields, fire-pits, an Olympic sized swimming pool, a stocked fishing lake, and many other wonderful things for your child to enjoy. We are also planning on providing the following activities: Archery, Canoeing, Crafts, Music, Hiking, Quilting, and Cooking/Baking. There are also many other "surprises" in the works, including a possible Carnival on Thursday night.

Our plans are to leave **Sunday, July 11** at **2:00 p.m.** from ARBC and return on **Friday, July 16** at approximately **3:30 p.m.** While we're away our primary focus will be making this a spiritual retreat for your child. We will have trained and dedicated volunteers from ARBC who will guide your child through a life-changing encounter with Jesus packed snugly inside a fun-filled, relaxing and unforgettable week!
